

BYD Zoo giveaway

Inchcape Belgium Distribution NV is organising a competition in which participants have the chance to win tickets to a zoo in Belgium.

The terms and conditions governing this competition are set out in these Terms and Conditions.

ARTICLE 1: ORGANISER

Inchcape Belgium Distribution NV, with its registered office at Leuvensesteenweg 369, 1932 Zaventem, Belgium, and registered with the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under company number 0459.491.374 (hereinafter referred to as the "Organiser"), is organising a competition (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition") under the terms and conditions set out below.

Please read these Terms and Conditions (hereinafter the "Terms and Conditions") carefully. By participating in the Competition, each participant confirms that they have read, understood and expressly accepted these Terms and Conditions.

ARTICLE 2: COMPETITION PERIOD

The Competition runs from 27 June 2026 until 23 August 2026 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition Period").

ARTICLE 3: ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

The Competition is open to individuals who book a test drive with one of the 25 official BYD dealers and meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Have completed the test drive.
- Are domiciled in Belgium.
- Are at least 18 years of age.
- Employees and/or any persons directly or indirectly involved in the organisation of the Competition, as well as their immediate family members or members of their household, are excluded from participation.

Participation in the Competition is free of charge and no purchase is necessary.

Participation is only possible via bydauto.be. Each participant may enter the Competition only once. Entries submitted through third parties or by automated means will be disqualified.

ARTICLE 4: HOW TO PARTICIPATE

To participate in the Competition and be eligible for the prize draw, participants must:

1. Request a test drive via bydauto.be with a BYD vehicle of their choice.
2. Attend the scheduled appointment at the selected BYD dealer and complete the test drive.

ARTICLE 5: WINNAAR EN KENNISGEVING

The winner will be selected by means of a random prize draw. One (1) winner will be selected and will receive family admission tickets to the zoo of their choice.

The winner will be notified by email on 24 August 2026. If the winner does not respond within the timeframe specified by the Organiser, the Organiser reserves the right to select an alternative winner.

ARTICLE 6: PRIZE

The prize consists of a maximum of four (4) admission tickets for the winner and their family to one of the following zoos in Belgium:

1. Pairi Daiza
2. ZOO Antwerpen
3. ZOO Planckendael
4. Pakawi Park

For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions, "family" shall be understood exclusively to mean the winner, their partner, and their direct children. Grandparents, grandchildren, siblings, other relatives, friends, or any other accompanying persons are not considered part of the family under these Terms and Conditions. If the winner's family consists of fewer than four (4) persons, no additional tickets will be provided for other individuals.

The prize is personal, non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or any other form of compensation.

If necessary, the Organiser reserves the right to substitute the prize with an alternative prize of equal value should the advertised prize become unavailable.

The prize consists solely of admission tickets. Parking fees, accommodation, transportation, food, beverages and any other expenses are not included in the prize.

ARTICLE 7: PRIVACY

For the purposes of the Competition, the Organiser processes the following personal data:

- Full name
- Email address

This personal data will be used solely for the administration of the Competition and will not be shared with third parties unless this is necessary for the organisation and execution of the Competition.

The personal data will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Requests for access, rectification or deletion of personal data may be submitted to:

Any personal data provided by a participant will be processed by the Organiser only to the extent necessary for the purposes of the Competition. Such data will not be disclosed to any third party except where required for the organisation and execution of the Competition and in compliance with all applicable data protection legislation.

The Organiser will retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes described above. Personal data will not be retained for longer than is strictly necessary.

By participating in the Competition, participants consent to the processing of their personal data in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

ARTICLE 8: AMENDMENTS AND LIABILITY

The Organiser shall not be liable for any interruption, suspension or cancellation of the Competition resulting from force majeure or any other circumstances beyond the Organiser's reasonable control.

The Organiser reserves the right, without incurring any liability, to restrict, amend, modify, suspend or cancel the Competition, these Terms and Conditions, or the prizes, or to make exceptions where circumstances so require.

Any amendments to these Terms and Conditions shall be deemed to form an integral part of these Terms and Conditions and will be published on the website www.bydauto.be. Participants are responsible for reviewing the Terms and Conditions regularly.

In such cases, participants (or any other person) shall not be entitled to individual notification or to any compensation or damages.

ARTICLE 9: TECHNICAL ISSUES - LIABILITY

The Organiser will use reasonable efforts to ensure that the Website remains accessible. However, due to the technical nature of the internet and IT systems, as well as the need to perform periodic maintenance, updates and upgrades, the Organiser cannot guarantee uninterrupted access to or availability of the Website. In the event of any normal and reasonable interruption or disruption, the Organiser will make reasonable efforts to restore access as soon as possible. Such interruptions or disruptions are inherent to internet-based services and shall not constitute a breach of these Terms and Conditions.

The Website is provided to participants without any express or implied warranty regarding its availability, functionality or performance. The Organiser shall not be liable for any direct or indirect damages resulting from the use of the Website, nor for any damages arising from incorrect, incomplete, ambiguous or outdated information, language errors on the Website, or participation in the Competition.

The Organiser will also make reasonable efforts to ensure access to the Competition and the accurate processing of all entries. However, errors may occur. The Organiser shall not be liable for lost entries or results, or for any errors in calculations or processing.

The Organiser shall not be liable for any interruption of the Website or the Competition resulting from technical failures, internet or connection issues, strikes, the unexpected closure of a BYD dealership, or any other similar circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

The Organiser makes no warranties regarding the suitability or fitness of the prize for any particular purpose. Neither the Organiser nor any third party engaged by the Organiser in connection with the Competition shall be liable for the use of the prize, any malfunction or failure relating to the prize, or for any direct or indirect damage arising from or connected with the prize, including, without limitation, material damage, personal injury or death.

Participants acknowledge that the Organiser and the availability of the prize are dependent on the opening hours and operating conditions of the selected zoo. The Organiser shall not be held liable if the relevant zoo decides to cancel the admission tickets or reschedule their validity to another date or location.

Except in cases of gross negligence, wilful misconduct or where liability cannot be excluded under applicable law, neither the Organiser, its employees, nor any third party engaged in connection with the Competition shall be liable for any damage or loss of any kind arising from participation in, or the organisation of, the Competition, or from the awarding or non-awarding of the prize.

In all cases, the Organiser's total liability shall be limited to the value of the prize awarded to the participant, as described in Article 6.

ARTICLE 10: DISQUALIFICATION, SUSPENSION OR CANCELLATION

Any breach of or fraud relating to these Terms and Conditions shall result in the participant's disqualification from the Competition. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant where there is clear and reasonable evidence or suspicion of fraud and/or a breach of these Terms and Conditions.

In the event of cheating, manipulation, abuse, deception or fraud (including, but not limited to, the provision of false or misleading personal data), or where there is a reasonable suspicion thereof, the participant concerned may be immediately excluded from the Competition and consequently from any eligibility to win a prize.

Participants who are disqualified shall be immediately and permanently excluded from the Competition and may also be barred from participating in any future competitions organised by the Organiser. In all such cases, the Organiser's decision shall be final and binding, and no appeal shall be possible.

The Organiser reserves the right to shorten, suspend, amend or cancel the Competition for any reason beyond its reasonable control or in the event of force majeure making it impossible to continue the Competition in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

Furthermore, the Organiser reserves the right to shorten, suspend, extend, amend or otherwise modify the Competition, the participation requirements, the prize, or any other aspect of the Competition at any time and at its sole discretion, including outside cases of force majeure, without participants being entitled to any compensation or other claim against the Organiser.

In the event of any amendment or suspension of these Terms and Conditions, the Organiser will clearly communicate such amendment or suspension through appropriate channels.

ARTICLE 11 : DISPUTES AND COMPLAINTS

All decisions made by the Organiser in connection with the Competition shall be final, irrevocable and binding. No appeal may be made against such decisions.

Any complaints relating to the Competition must be submitted to the Organiser by registered mail no later than seven (7) calendar days after the end of the Competition.

Complaints submitted after the above-mentioned deadline or submitted in any form other than in writing shall not be considered.

ARTICLE 12 : GENERAL PROVISIONS

By participating in the Competition, participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organiser from and against any claims, costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind arising out of or in connection with the Competition or the acceptance, possession or use of the prize, except in cases of death or personal injury caused by the Organiser's negligence, fraud or any other unlawful act.

No act or omission by the Organiser shall be construed as a waiver of any of its rights.

Should one or more provisions of these Terms and Conditions be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

The Competition shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Belgium. Any disputes arising in connection with the Competition shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Belgium.

By participating in the Competition, participants are deemed to have read, understood and accepted these Terms and Conditions.
